



These "REKØL" hinges should be used for built-in fridges. They have a limited opening angle, and are possible to adjust after the fridge has been fully installed.





Insert the plastic dowels into the door's pre-drilled holes with a hammer.





Press the 95 degree hinges into the door and fasten them using the screws with flat tips.





Predrill the fastening holes with a 2 mm / 1/16" drill bit. The holes should be approximately 10 mm / 3/8" in depth.





Make sure that the arrow on the fastening bracket lines up with the holes. Note that the screws will not fit into any of the pre-drilled holes.





Install the fastening bracket using the self-tapping screws.

Install the door.

Adjust the door by turning the screws on all the hinges.
